Picking buckets are cleaned before and after each use, stored on the back covered deck of the farmstand. Plastic bins are pressure washed before use and stored in insulated container when not in use.

All our wholesale produce is packed and shipped in new waxed boxes.

All shipping containers are new and stored under cover away from pests and weather.
